
Dear Keith,

This letter shall serve as our final report for the above-mentioned grant agreement. The project was for the Native Habitat Restoration and Invasive Species Control for Indian Head Canyon, Encinitas, and Rancho Carillo, Carlsbad. During the grant period our project treated 24.84 acres of invasive species throughout the project area, reduced or removed the associated biomass, and retreated over 34.5 acres of invasive species (some retreatment areas had been previously treated with matching funding sources). Our project installed, watered, and maintained 450 native plants within the project area.











Retreatments of pampas grass, arundo, perennial pepperweed, and artichoke thistle at Rancho Carillo and Indianhead.
