Directions to The Institute for Conservation Research

15600 San Pasqual Valley Road, Escondido, CA 92027 (next to the San Diego Zoo Safari Park).

(Directions are the same for traveling north or south on the I-15)

Take exit 27 off I-15 - Via Rancho Parkway

Turn RIGHT (east) on to Via Rancho Parkway. Go 0.8 miles and then

Turn RIGHT (east) on to San Pasqual Road. Go 3.4 miles and then

At the light, turn RIGHT (east) on to San Pasqual Valley Road. Go 1.3 miles

There will be signs all along the route for the “San Diego Zoo Safari Park.”

Drive 100 meters past the main entrance to the Safari Park, then turn LEFT into the driveway for the Institute for Conservation Research. On the call box on the left, press “Beckman Center” to contact the front desk, and someone will let you through the front gate. Drive all the way down the parking lot - the Beckman Center is the second building.
