## Land Management Assistant

The Land Management Assistant is a vital part of the organization, providing hands on support to maintain and enhance the safety of hiking trails, while improving the ecological function of the preserves for native flora and fauna.

# **Responsibilities and Duties:**

- Keep trails, fences, and structures in good condition by checking and repairing regularly.
- Trim, thin, and/or remove vegetation for trail clearance and/or defensible space setbacks.
- Safely transport and use tools (hand and power), materials, and other equipment.
- Implement or repair erosion control structures.
- Remove exotic plant species from biologically sensitive areas.
- Revegetate restoration areas with appropriate species.
- Educate trail goers on proper trail etiquette and practices.

# **Qualifications:**

- Minimum High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Ability to work outside in varying terrain and weather conditions.
- Knowledge of appropriate Personal Protective Equipment for the tools used and job at hand.
- Vehicle with the ability to transport materials to and from site (truck with 4x4 preferred).
- Valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
- Willingness to learn by participating in trainings.
- Knowledge of local flora and fauna and common non-native species.
